Re: Cross-listed courses


Dear Professor Gingerich:

It is the Graduate Academic Board's and Undergraduate Academic Board's intention that its signing up for the offering of a cross-listed course may be charged with tuition and differing course fees. The tuition and fees differ based on the institution from which the student enrolls. This is due to unequal fees and tuitions across colleges and universities. We find this to be unfair to students enrolled in these cross-listed courses. The Registrar's Office when, partway through the semester, has notified students and asked to transfer to the appropriate prefix.
