**Recommendations**

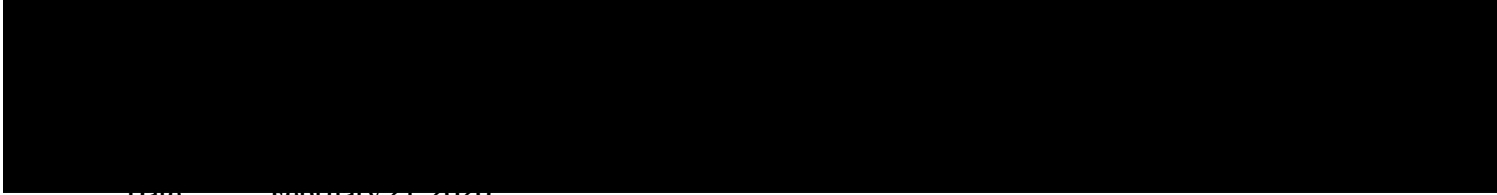
