These metrics must also be used to inform and implement improvement strategies and allocate resources to promote equity in student achievement. To that end, the Chancellor's Cabinet recently adopted a student success protocol requesting all programs aimed at improving student success to centrally identify program participants so that the effectiveness of programs and services can be measured. This request for information is a first step in our process of establishing a framework for reporting.
